Equi-Spirit™ Horse Ball Let Your Horse Play-The Natural Way

Thank you for your purchase of our Equi-Spirit™ Horse Ball. We know your horses will enjoy this ball and we're sure you'll have as much fun watching them.

WARNINGS

1. **Do not** over-inflate ball. See below for proper inflation instructions.
2. Keep away from heat or open flame.
3. Avoid contact with sharp objects.
4. Be safe! Horses can get very excited when playing with their ball.
5. Supervision is recommended.
6. Some horses may be timid of the ball at first. Take your time properly introducing him/her to it.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Unfold the bladder until flat. Find the plug and position the bladder with the plug facing to the right or left. Roll the bladder up from the bottom to the top just like a sleeping bag. Roll the bladder as tightly as possible. The bladder should now be oblong in shape. Insert into the covering with the end with the plug going in last. Twist the bladder a little and it should slide into the cover. Remove the plug to inflate the bladder.
2. Inflate immediately upon purchase and let sit for 24 hours. Deflate and put away if the ball is not going to be used immediately.
3. Use a double action hand pump to inflate. If you wish you may use an air compressor or gas station tire inflator. **If you are using an automatic method of inflation blow up the ball for 3 seconds, let it set for 45 seconds and then repeat until the ball is completely inflated.**
4. **NOTE: The bladder will become tight at 24-28"; KEEP inflating the ball until the cover is smooth with no wrinkles but not so tight you can't pinch some of the covering between the fingers.**
5. Replace plug and secure hook and loop closure.

STORAGE

1. Do not store in extreme temperatures.
2. When not in use, ball should be stored a room temperature.
3. Store the ball fully or partially inflated if possible. If that is not possible, store it flat.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

1. To wash outer cover, deflate inner bladder completely and remove bladder from outer cover.
2. Wash in cold water using laundry detergent.
3. **DO NOT** use bleach.
4. Dry with **LOW HEAT** or drip dry.
5. After material cover is dry, insert bladder back into cover being careful to position inflation hole near hook and loop covering. Re-inflate ball.
